Results for each provider are published on the DfE School and College Performance Data website and used to inform Ofsted inspections. It is therefore vital for FE providers to understand how their performance holds up against these measures, making sure that any issues are identified and addressed in good time.

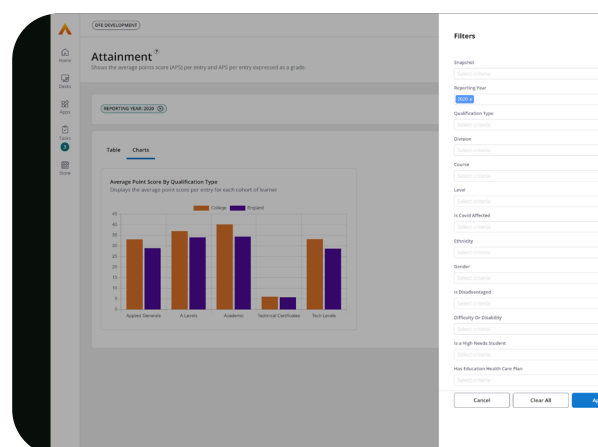


Data can be exported to Microsoft Excel to enable integration with existing documents, reports, and dashboards.
